Committed to Success

On any given day at South Greenville, one doesn't have to look hard to find students energetically engaged in the classroom and teachers integrating technology into their lessons. The home of the Cheetahs has a 1:1

technology ratio for students in grades 3-5, providing students with a basic understanding of how computer tools operate as well as confidence and knowledge that will support

them in becoming productive citizens.

Each year, the school hosts a Tech Fest during which students show off projects they've completed using the technology available to them.

Parents are also given numerous chances to visit the school and be involved in their child's education, including during the annual Cheetah Goal Bowl that rewards student academic success for the entire year. School officials also welcome volunteers throughout the year.



Fast Forward Program

Students at South Greenville Elementary have the unique opportunity to get a jumpstart on the next school year through the district's only Fast Forward program. In this initiative, students who are promoted to the next grade level attend school 30 days during the summer to preview the material they will need to know for the upcoming school year and begin learning some of the concepts



that will make them more successful in the classroom.

A school day during Fast Forward includes all of the as-

pects of a typical school day including art, music, media, and physical education classes as well as lunch and breakfast for all students. The program will include all grade levels except kindergarten during its first year, but plans are in place to expand it to those beginning school in future years.

AVID Education

Beginning in 2017, South Greenville Elementary will have an AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) focus to help it close the achievement gap by preparing all students for college readiness and success in a global society.

In 30-plus years, AVID has proven time and time again that, when given a system of rigorous curriculum and strategic support, students can be

academically successful. AVID Elementary is a foundational component of the AVID College Readiness System and supports AVID's mission and vision to provide a comprehensive model of success for all students from elementary through higher education.

Based on the same learning foundation that underlies AVID Secondary, AVID Elementary is designed to be embedded into the daily instruction of all elementary classrooms, across entire grade levels, to impact school-wide structures. Like AVID Secondary, AVID Elementary essentials focus on the four necessary areas to ensure that all students are poised for academic success: instruction; culture; leadership; and systems.
