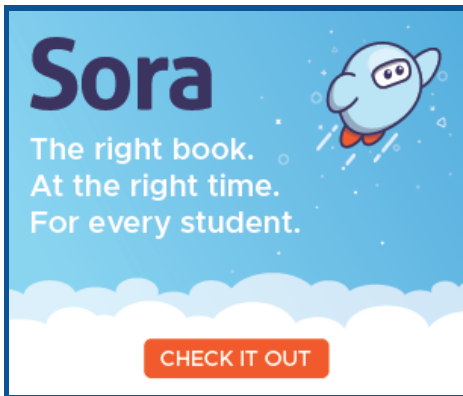

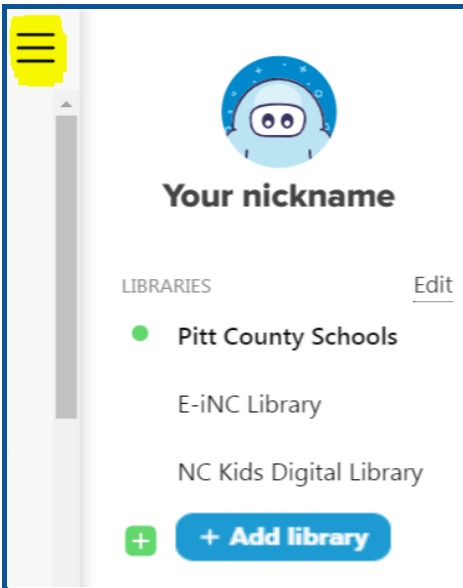


Go to <https://soraapp.com/home> or download the app on iTunes or Google Play. Search for Pitt County Schools.

Staff and students can log in with their PCS network username and password.

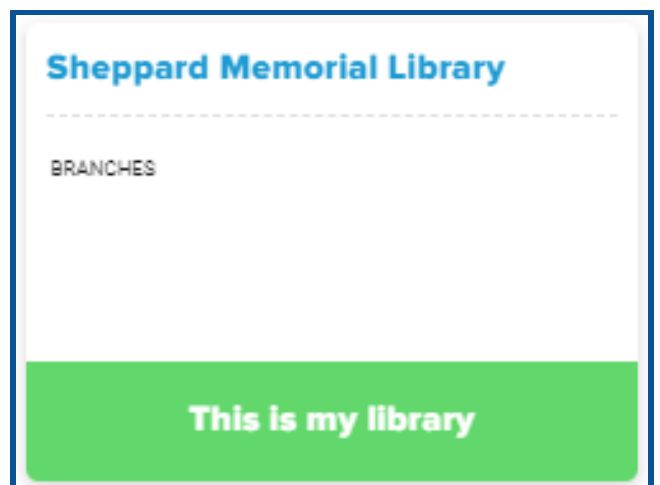
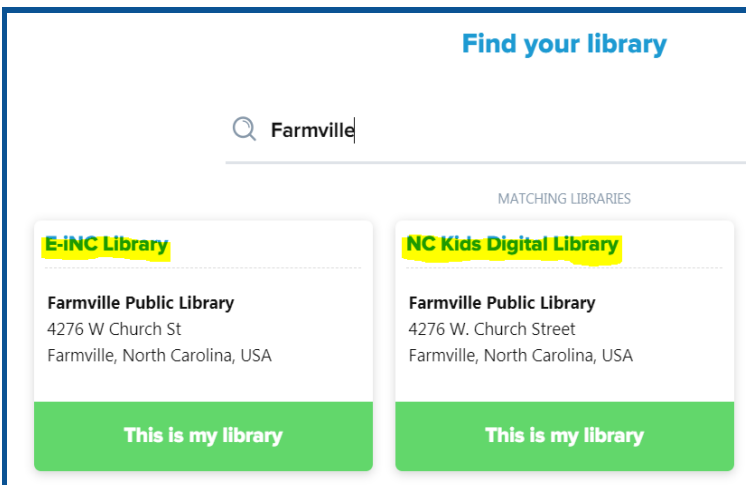
To access even more books, you can add the E-iNC Library and NC Kids Digital Library. Here's how:

-Click the three small lines in the top right corner to expand the menu. Click **+ Add library**



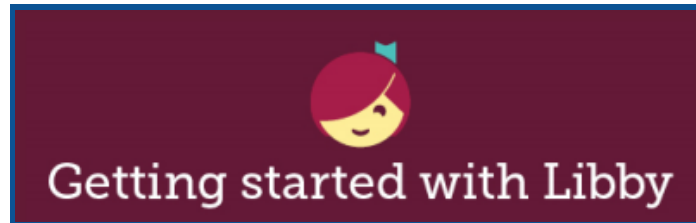
Search for Farmville. You can add E-INC Library and NC Digital Kids Library. Use your PowerSchool Student ID number as your library card number and the last four digits of your ID as your PIN.

Search for Sheppard. Add Sheppard Memorial Library.

Libby



Libby and Sora are both products of OverDrive, and they work the same way.

PCS students have access to Libby through a partnership with Sheppard Memorial Library.

Install the Libby app from the app store on your Android or iOS (iPhone/iPad/iPod touch) device; or, visit libbyapp.com in your Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Edge browser.

When logging in for the first time:

- You will be asked if you have a library card. Say YES.
- Follow the prompts to find your public library (Sheppard Memorial Library).
- Enter your Student ID number as your library card number.

Browse your library's collection and borrow a title.

Borrowed titles appear under Shelf > Loans and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.

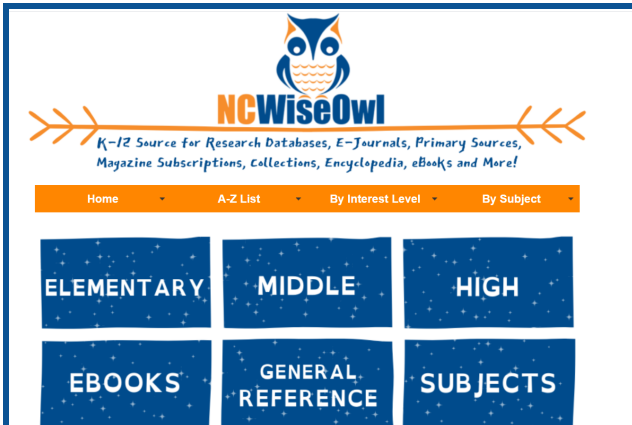
From your **Loans**, you can:

- Tap **Read With...** to choose whether you'd like to open a book in Kindle (U.S. libraries only) or Libby.
- Tap **Open Audiobook** or **Open Magazine** to start reading or listening to that title.
- Tap **Manage Loan** to see options like **Renew** and **Return**.

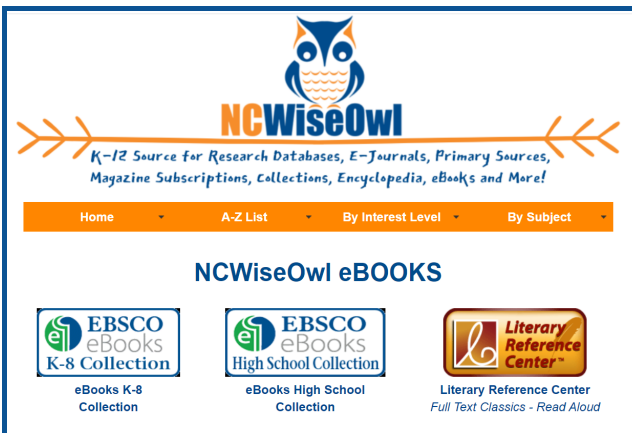


Go to www.ncwiseowl.org. Click the blue eBooks box on the left side of the screen.

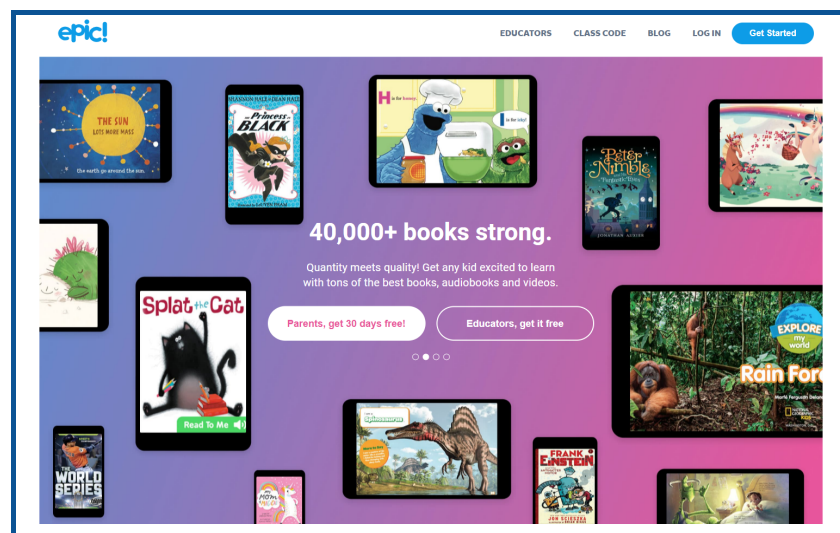


