How will you prepare for WorkKeys?

What can I do to prepare for the test?

- Take the three Pretests to target the area that you will need to spend the most time preparing.
- Each Pretest Submission will generate practice exercises to help you prepare for the test.
- <u>After you have taken all three Pretests</u>, work through the exercises for the levels for each test.
- It will be review. That is okay. The purpose is to show you each kind of question you will see.

What will I get out of the deal?

If you complete the three pretests by November 8th, you will receive a wristband that allows you to wear jeans on November 10th.

What do the levels mean?

- Your score will be a level...1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7.
- Each level grows progressively more difficult.
- The practice exercises will allow you to see very easy and very difficult questions. Try them all.
- If you encounter something you can't do, take notes and ask an appropriate teacher for help before February.
- The exercises will also provide instruction. Pay attention.

How will I be scored?

- WorkKeys score is determined by the number of questions answered correctly.
- There is no penalty for guessing.
- Each skill level description explains the skills you can successfully apply on a job.
- Employers use levels to decide who to hire and how to scale salaries.

Will I receive a score report?

- You get a score report for each section.
- It will have the level attained and an explanation of what skills you can do in the workplace.


