Leaders: Mrs. Nosie and Mrs. Howell

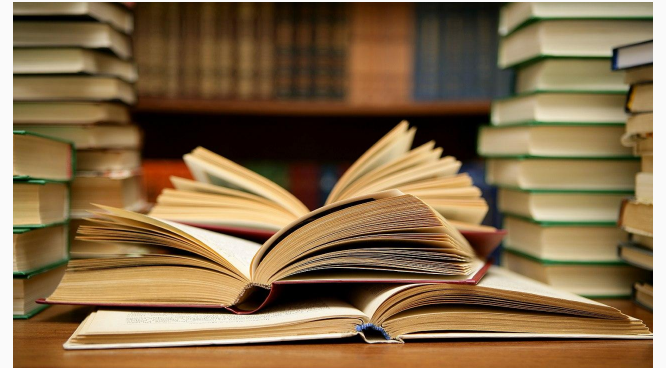
Students will learn how to work cooperatively in groups and work on good sportsmanship while playing board games.

Leader: Coach Paulk

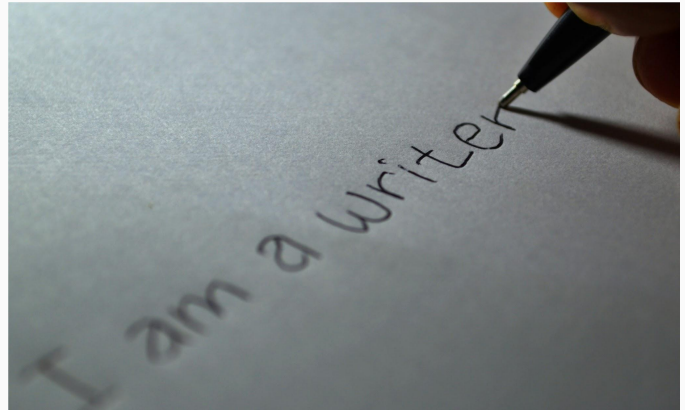
5th Grade Boys only: boys will learn how to conduct themselves as a young man, and learn how to become a positive role model in their community.

Leader: Mrs. Pridmore

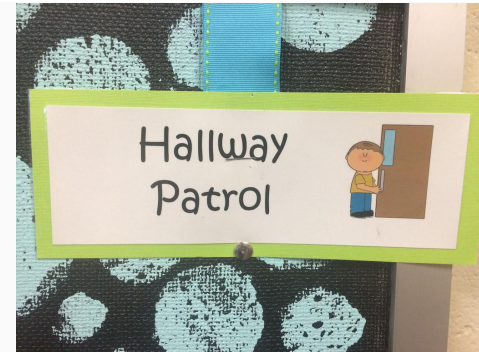

Leaders: Mrs. Bray and Ms. Corpening

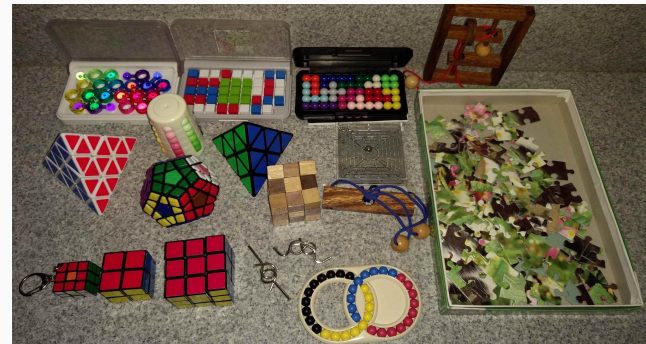

Leaders: Mrs. Herring and Mrs. Ratte

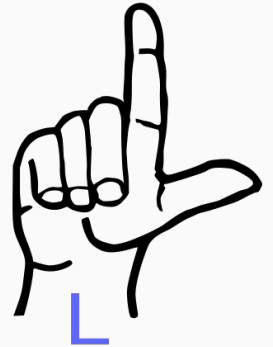

Leader: Mrs. O'Campo

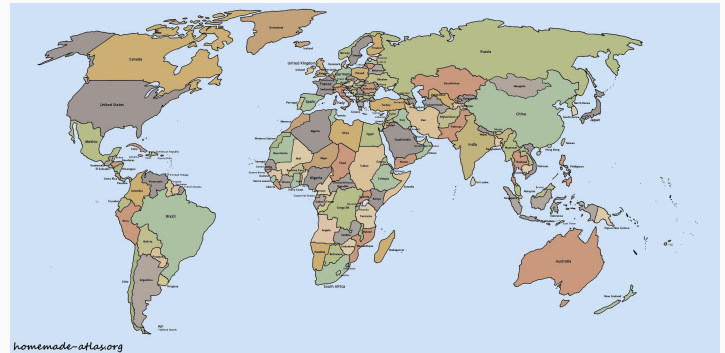
Start with weaving paper to learn process and then work on a yarn weaving
