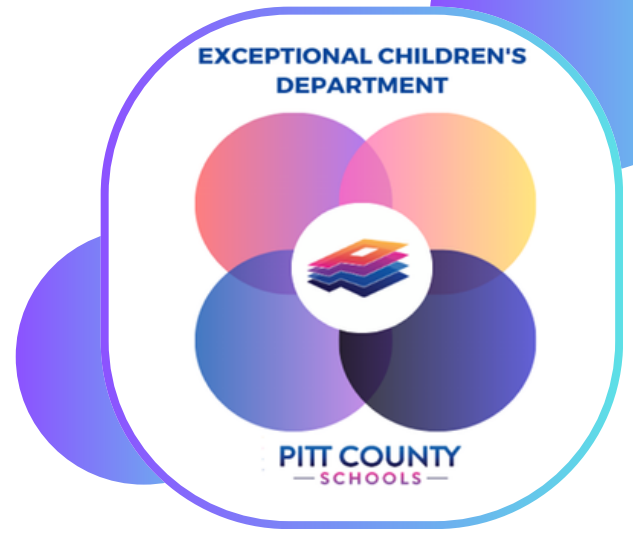

Who?

Students ages 3-5 who have been determined eligible for special education services.



What?

Eligible students are provided services outlined in the Individualized Education Program (IEP). The IEP provides services requiring specially designed instruction.



How?

The EC PreK Program provides specially designed instruction through developmentally appropriate learning experiences that help to bridge the gap in identified areas of delay.



Where?

The EC PreK Program offers a continuum of services for eligible students based on the services outlined in the IEP. Preschool special education services are provided at the following locations: Belvoir Elementary, Chicod School, Creekside Elementary, Falkland Elementary, Sadie Saulter PreK Program, and Stokes School. Itinerant services can be provided in a student's home or child care center.

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
