Pitt County Schools Exceptional Children's Pre-K Program is committed to giving all children, with and without disabilities, the opportunity for an exceptional educational experience, preparing them for kindergarten and beyond. Children in the program learn and play together in a warm, supportive, language-enriched environment, where differences are accepted and celebrated.

Our EC Pre-K Classrooms

Pitt County Schools Exceptional Children's Pre-K Program serves children age 3-5 years old who have been evaluated, found eligible for special education and require specially designed instruction to meet the unique needs of a child with a disability. Our program offers a variety of settings to best meet the needs of each individual child and are designed to provide developmentally appropriate learning experiences.

The EC Pre-K Program is supplemental to a child's Regular Early Childhood Program. It is our goal to provide each child with the tools and strategies they need to be successful in their Regular Early Childhood Program.

Young children need time to fully explore their environment. It is for this reason that our EC Pre-K Program is built around flexible blocks of time. Routines contribute to the physical and emotional well-being of young children. Routines such as arrival and departure, eating, and toileting are an important part of a child's day. Our teachers create an environment where children learn to make choices, are encouraged to communicate with others, and learn to share and work together.



Pitt County EC Pre-K Classrooms

Teacher implement the High Scope Curriculum which aligns with the North Carolina Foundations for Early Learning, and formal assessment Teaching Strategies Gold. Services for students with disabilities are provided according to their Individualized Education Program (IEP). Academic, communication, daily living skills, and social-emotional supports are integrated into classroom learning experiences.

All classrooms are led by certified teachers with training in preschool education. These classrooms are designed to provide developmentally appropriate learning experiences for 3, 4, and 5 year old children.

We want students to enjoy school and develop a strong sense of self-worth. Classroom experiences will include many opportunities for active, hands-on learning.
