## **Reports of Committees**

Membership: 221 Members added.

Advocacy/Education: Mary Gaskins added to the committee. National lunch week going well. Two volunteers today. ECU dance team volunteering on Friday. 6-8 Academic breakfast is Nov. 5th. Feb 4th and April 7th are other breakfast dates. Food drive-Students against hunger. Oct. 1-December 6th. Collects food for the food bank. Will need to be discussed with Mr. Pollard. Courtney Yates asked if this is something already being done by counselors. Mrs. Evans was unsure but will check with Mr. Pollard. Mary says that all food would be sent to Food Bank but the food stays in the area. Food Bank is willing to pick up food from the school but it is donated to the whole bank. Courtney Yates suggested that PTA partner with school social workers/counselors to work on a food drive. This would allow clubs to participate and receive volunteer hours. Another option for partnership with the Food Bank would be a change drive. The Kelly will explore this with Mr. Pollard and Mrs. Jeffries. Mrs. Evans will get touch base with Mr. Pollard about this. Courtney Yates is also willing to work in partnership through the system that is in place at Conley.

Kelly would like to look into water bottle filling stations. There is a grant available online to fill out so that these could be free. This will be discussed with Mr. Pollard to see if this is an option. Hands only CPR for the kids. Kelly would like to see this taught in kids PE classes so that kids are exposed to this life saving method. It would help alleviate the fear of performing CPR by teaching it at an early age. Mary Gaskins is waiting for information from the school nurse to see what is already available and to see what resources are available. The AHA has a curriculum for teaching hands-on CPR. Possibly guest teachers. Mr. Pollard will be approached about this.
