I am writing this letter to let you know that Wahl-Coates Elementary has been designated as an Additional Targeted Support & Improvement (ATSI) school by the North Carolina State Board of Education. Per ESSA Section 1111(d)(2)(C), schools are identified as ATSI schools in North Carolina because one or more of the following subgroups received a subgroup performance grade score at or below the highest identified CSI-LP school's All Students group during the identification year; and is on the TSI-CU list for the subgroup(s) for the previous year. Subgroup performance scores are provided for the following subgroups: (1) Students with Disabilities, (2) Economically Disadvantaged, (3) Black, (4) White, (5) Hispanic, (6) Asian-Pacific Islander, (7) Multi-racial, and (8) English Learners. This letter is to notify our parents and guardians of Wahl-Coates Elementary school's intentions to improve educational outcomes for underperforming student subgroups and close achievement gaps for all students.

As an ATSI school, Wahl-Coates Elementary_ is required to develop an Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) plan that specifically addresses how the school will improve outcomes for underperforming subgroups. The plan will also include strategies that our district or charter will employ to support Wahl-Coates Elementary School's improvement efforts. The ATSI plan will address the following areas:

We have set the following goals for Wahl-Coates Elementary this year:

 By June 2026, Wahl-Coates Elementary will increase the overall school proficiency rate on state end-of-grade-assessments by at least 5 percentage points from 2024-2025 baseline.

Here are some strategies that we will be implementing to improve student outcomes:

• Within the 2025-2026 school year, our school will implement the following evidenced-based intervention(s): small group instruction in core content areas, reading horizions, sound city, and elevate to increase overall student performance.
