## UPDATED 2017/2018 SCHOOL DRESS CODE

- ANY solid color shirts with a collar with small manufacturer's logo or school-approved logo.
- Solid Khaki, Black, or Navy Bottoms (Jumpers, Pants, Capris, Shorts, Skorts, and Skirts) and Dresses
- Denim bottoms must be solid khaki, black, or navy (blue jeans are permitted) with NO holes or cuts.
- Dresses, shorts, skorts, skirts, and jumpers must be modest and of sufficient length. The length of these articles of clothing may not be above the student's fingertips when the student's arms are relaxed at his or her sides.
- Dresses must have a collar and sleeves.
- Footed tights may be worn under pants, capris, shorts, skorts, skirts, dresses, or jumpers
- Solid colored sweatshirts, sweaters, jackets, coats, hoodies, and vests, including lightweight fleece jackets, over school attire with small manufacturer's logo or school-approved logo.
- Hoodies and hooded jackets may <u>not</u> have the hood covering the head while in a school building.
- Creekside spirit wear\* and school club wear can be worn every Friday as well as for special events.
