4. K-12, K-8 and 9-12 Principals' Meetings
5. Area Principals' Meetings with Superintendent
6. Public Input at Board of Education Meetings
7. Board of Education Committee Meetings
8. NCAE/Superintendent Meetings
9. Superintendent/Student Advisory Committee
10. Principal representative at Superintendent's staff meetings
11. Ad Hoc Committees to study specific issues
