

HOSPITAL/HOMEBOUND PROGRAMS FOR REGULAR
AND EXCEPTIONAL STUDENTS

It is the policy of the Pitt County Board of Education to provide hospital/homebound services to regular and exceptional students who are disabled to the extent that they are unable to attend school. These students may receive one-on-one instruction from a hospital/homebound teacher at Pitt County Memorial Hospital, in their homes or in a location determined by the Superintendent or his/her designee.

These programs will operate within Pitt County's established guidelines set forth in Pitt County Schools' Hospital Program and Pitt County Schools' Homebound Program.
