INTERDISTRICT RELATIONS WITH HIGHER EDUCATION

The Pitt County Board of Education will maintain contact with other school administrative units and institutions of higher education to work together for the total community.

Dual Enrollment

Students from high schools in Pitt County Schools may be permitted to take courses for credit at Pitt Community College, East Carolina University or other post-secondary institutions. Each student will be required to pay the fees per hour of credit as listed in the current catalog at the time of enrollment.

Dual Enrollment may be approved if the following criteria and procedures are met and followed:

- 1. The student meets the post-secondary institution's admission requirements.
- 2. The student has a recommendation from a high school counselor and approval from the principal of the high school where currently enrolled.
- 3. The course is not available at the high school of attendance or another high school in the county.
- 4. When a student enrolls in a course and receives a failing grade, the student will be ineligible for further participation in the program area.
- 5. When a student desires to withdraw from a class, the institution's procedures must be followed.
- 6. The high school schedule will not be changed to accommodate courses taken at a post-secondary institution. Further, it may not be possible for the high school to schedule classes for the student to allow for off-campus study.
- 7. The student should not be excused from high school classes at any time for the purpose of studying or for any other purpose connected with the college work. The student will not be released from a class early or allowed to enter a class late as a result of off-campus post-secondary courses.
- 8. High school credit may be awarded only with prior approval by the school principal and the Associate Superintendent for Educational Programs and Services, or his/her designee.
