HOMEWORK

Homework shall be a part of the instructional experiences of each student. Homework is a purposeful extension of the instructional program to be accomplished by the student outside the regular class. Homework shall be planned carefully and evaluated periodically regarding its purpose, appropriateness and timeliness. The weighted value of homework should not exceed 20 percent of a student's total six-week grade cycle.

The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent to develop and implement homework guidelines that will enhance student learning.
