CLASS RANKING OF STUDENTS

All students in high school shall be ranked solely on quality points as assigned by the state standards. Ties will not be broken using grades. In figuring quality points for class rank, the correct procedure is to add the total number of quality points and divide by the total number of courses attempted. If a student fails a course and receives no quality points for that course, the course must be included in the division factor.

A ranking in grade 11 shall be completed at the end of the second marking period of the second semester to determine participation in end-of-year functions. A ranking in grade 12 shall be completed at the end of the second semester final exam period. Rankings obtained from this calculation shall be used for all graduation exercise functions. Final rankings are computed at the end of the second semester final marking period for all 9-12 students. A North Carolina standardized transcript containing class rank will be provided to each high school student at least one time during the school year.
