

REPEATED COURSES IN GRADES 9-12

The Board endorses the following guidelines for students in grades 9-12 who desire to repeat a course:

1. Students should be permitted to take a course again if they fail.
2. If students retake a course that they have previously failed, both attempts will be counted in the grade point average (GPA). This means that each course attempted will be used in computing class rank.

DROP-ADD IN GRADES 9-12

The drop-add period for valid educational reasons will extend through the first five (5) days of school.

If students drop a course after the first five (5) days of school, they will receive a failing grade for that course, and the failing grade will be used in computing class rank.

Medical drops will be made without penalty.
