## REPEATED COURSES IN GRADES 9-12

The Board endorses the following guidelines for students in grades 9-12 who desire to repeat a course:

- 1. Students should be permitted to take a course again if they fail.
- 2. If students retake a course that they have previously failed, both attempts will be counted in the grade point average (GPA). This means that each course attempted will be used in computing class rank.

## DROP-ADD IN GRADES 9-12

The drop-add period for valid educational reasons will extend through the first five (5) days of school.

If students drop a course after the first five (5) days of school, they will receive a failing grade for that course, and the failing grade will be used in computing class rank.

Medical drops will be made without penalty.
