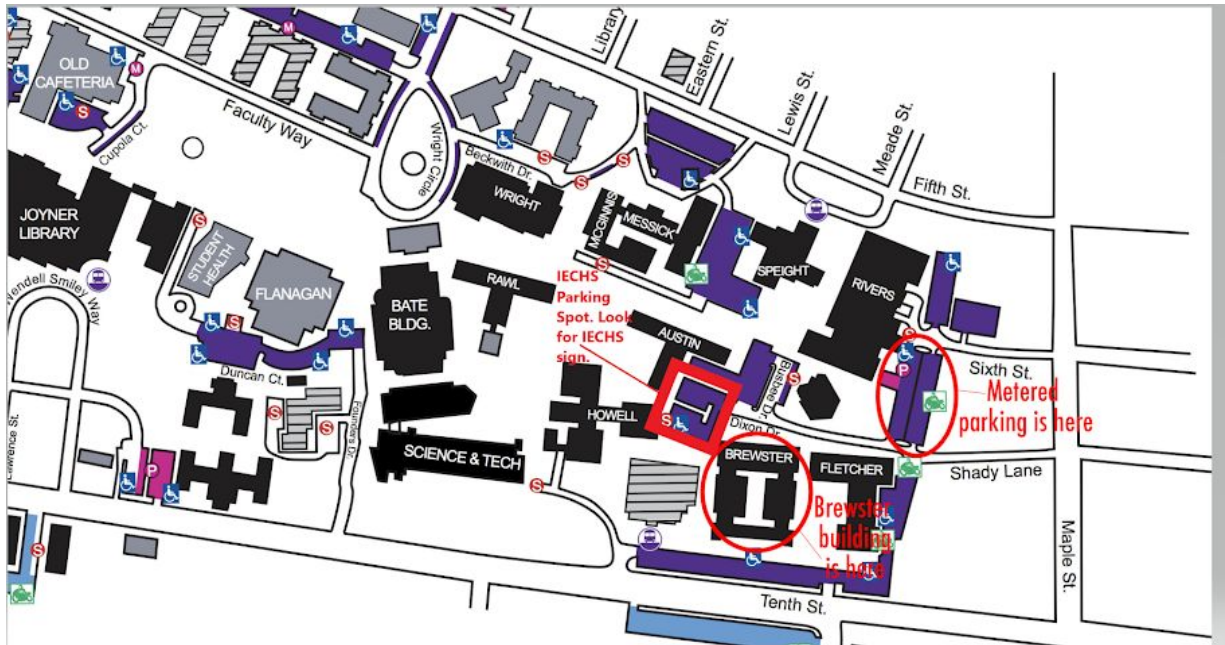


IECHS Parking Information



We have one parking space available for IECHS visitors at the end of Dixon Drive behind the Brewster building (see photo below of what the space looks like--it's right next to a dumpster). We do protect this one parking spot for our cafeteria staff in the morning (from ~8-9:30am) and at lunch time (from ~11:45am-2pm). About IECHS

IECHS is a public Pitt County Schools STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Math) and AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) high school located on East Carolina University's campus. IECHS students were selected from an application and interview process during their 8th grade/rising 9th grade year. Students attending this school will have the opportunity to graduate from high school in four to five years with up to 60 university transfer credits for free.

Since it is the first year of the school's existence, there are only 55 students (all freshmen) that make up the student body. Each year, 55 more freshmen will be added to the program.

53% of the current population of students are economically disadvantaged; 64% are first-generation college students. This program is academically-driven, so there are minimal club opportunities, and no sports, music, art, or JROTC programs; however, students have the opportunity to individualize their course sequences and STEAM pathways to include online and ECU courses related to these subjects.
