Thank you for considering the Early College High School experience! We are excited to recruit another class of incoming Freshmen for the 2024-2025 school year. Pitt County Schools have two options for you to consider: Innovation Early College High School at ECU(IECHS) and Pitt County Schools Early College High School(PCSECHS). Both programs offer a wide range of academic programs, small class sizes, academic rigor, and an overall quality education that is personalized to meet the needs of students.

To be considered for this unique learning opportunity, an application must be completed. Students may apply to one or both programs. **If applying for both, you must indicate which program is your first choice. Please note, you will be placed on the waiting list of your second choice.** In order to assist you in deciding which program might be the best fit, we invite you to attend one of our family information sessions, as well as a student information session to be held at each middle school.

To apply, students must submit a completed application, one teacher recommendation, and if applying to PCSECHS, a Pitt Community College application. Applications should be submitted to your school counselor or if homeschooled to the early college(s) that you are applying to by **Friday**, **January 12**, **2024.** Incomplete applications will not be considered. Once applications are received and evaluated, selected students will be invited to interview. Each year IECHS admits 55 students and PCSECHS admits 75.
