

It is the policy of the board to provide hospital/homebound services to students whose medical circumstances render the students unable to attend school. These students may receive one-on-one instruction from a hospital/homebound teacher at Pitt County Memorial Hospital, in their homes, or in a location determined by the superintendent or designee.

These programs will operate in accordance with any legal requirements and within Pitt County's established guidelines set forth in *Pitt County Schools' Hospital Program* and *Pitt County Schools' Homebound Program*.
