The representative from CFNC for Spanish Services, Juana Hernandez, will present in Spanish on how to pay for college. She will provide information on the FAFSA application and how to complete. In addition, the types of loans and scholarships available to students will be covered. She will also share information on how students can attend and pay for college if they are undocumented or in the DACA status. PCC Financial Aid members will be able to help students complete their FAFSA applications after the presentation.

To complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you need the following:

- Your Social Security number
- Your foreigner registration number (if you are not a US citizen)
- Copies of your 2018 federal tax return, W-2 forms and other proof of income.

(Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information to the FAFSA using the IRS Data Transfer and Query Tool.)

- Bank statements and investment records (if applicable)
- Proof of non-taxable income (if applicable)
- An FSA ID credential to sign the application electronically.

What is the FSA ID credential?

Please be aware that parents who have an ITIN number should not create a FSA ID. ITIN numbers always start with the number nine / 9.
