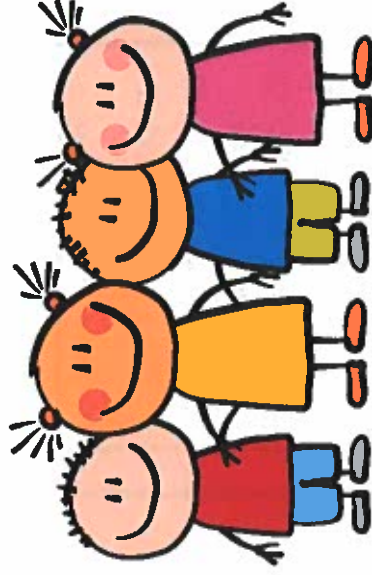
Active learning is at the center of the HighScope Curriculum. It's the foundation of young children gaining knowledge through their natural play and interactions.

The NC Pre-K Child

- Must be four-years-old on or before August 31st of the current program year
- Must provide a birth certificate and immunization record
- Must provide income documentation
- Approved developmental screening instruments must be administered by screening professionals
- A health assessment must be completed by a doctor within 30 days of enrollment
