



What is the Brody RISE Pre-College Program?

The Brody RISE Pre-College Program provides academic enrichment and health care exposure to learners from diverse backgrounds. In keeping with the mission of the Brody School of Medicine, Brody RISE works to increase the supply of primary-care physicians serving the state, improve the health status of citizens in eastern North Carolina, and enhance the access of disadvantaged and minority students to a medical education.

Who can attend the Brody RISE Pre-College Program?

Students in Wellcome Middle School and North Pitt High School are qualified to attend the program. Once admitted, we offer rigorous science and math-based enrichment classes and healthcare exposure activities to participants in grades 6th-12th with a minimum B average in all academic courses.

What activities do you offer?

After School- focuses on advanced-level coursework and provides study assistance for participants.

Saturday Academy - designated Saturdays with an intensive math, science, and career awareness curricula held on the campus of ECU at the Brody School of Medicine.

Summer Programs - one or two-week camp held on campus with STEM, medical, and laboratory research opportunities. Also includes evening activities and trips.
