COVID-19 Symptoms/Exposure and Return to School Guide

Please contact the school prior to your student returning back to school. If a student is excluded from school for symptoms and does not provide a COVID RT-PCR test result or a physician note; all siblings who are PCS students as well as adults who are staff members of PCS must also quarantine. The guidance below will be used to determine when your student can return.

No self-administered tests can be accepted for clearance to return to school.

- **Symptoms present, but no COVID-19 test:** 10 days after first date symptoms began, no fever for 24 hours (without the use of fever reducing medicine), AND student has no symptoms, including cough and shortness of breath. Dates of quarantine for your student: _____ May return to school: _____
- **Symptoms present, but negative COVID-19 rapid antigen test:** A negative rapid antigen test performed in a physician's office and accompanied with alternate diagnosis from provider can be submitted for return to school. Student can return once fever free for 24 hours (without the use of fever reducing medicine), no vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours AND student has felt well for 24 hours.
- **Negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test after exposure (conducted on Day 6 or later after exposure during 10 day quarantine period):** With no symptoms, no fever for 24 hours (without the use of fever reducing medicine), AND student has felt well for 24 hours.
- **Confirmed positive test for COVID-19:** 10 days after the first date symptoms began or if no symptoms, 10 days after date of COVID-19 test with no fever for 24 hours (without the use of fever reducing medicine). AND student has no symptoms, including cough and shortness of breath.
- **Household exposure (students living in the same house with someone who has COVID-19 symptoms or who was confirmed positive for Covid-19):** Students must quarantine while housemate recovers AND 10 days after the date of housemate's positive test or onset of symptoms. **In addition, the exposed individual (s) quarantine period does NOT begin until Day 11, with the option to test on Day 16. PCS requires all housemates to complete the full quarantine period and no exceptions are allowed.** Please contact school for further guidance on return date.
- **Outside of household exposure:** 10 days after the last date of exposure to a person with COVID-19 symptoms or who was confirmed positive AND student has no development of symptoms (*Please see guidance for negative COVID-19 test*).
- **Written confirmation of alternate diagnosis other than COVID-19 is required** (example: stomach virus, ear infection, strep throat) follow normal PCS polices to return to school.
