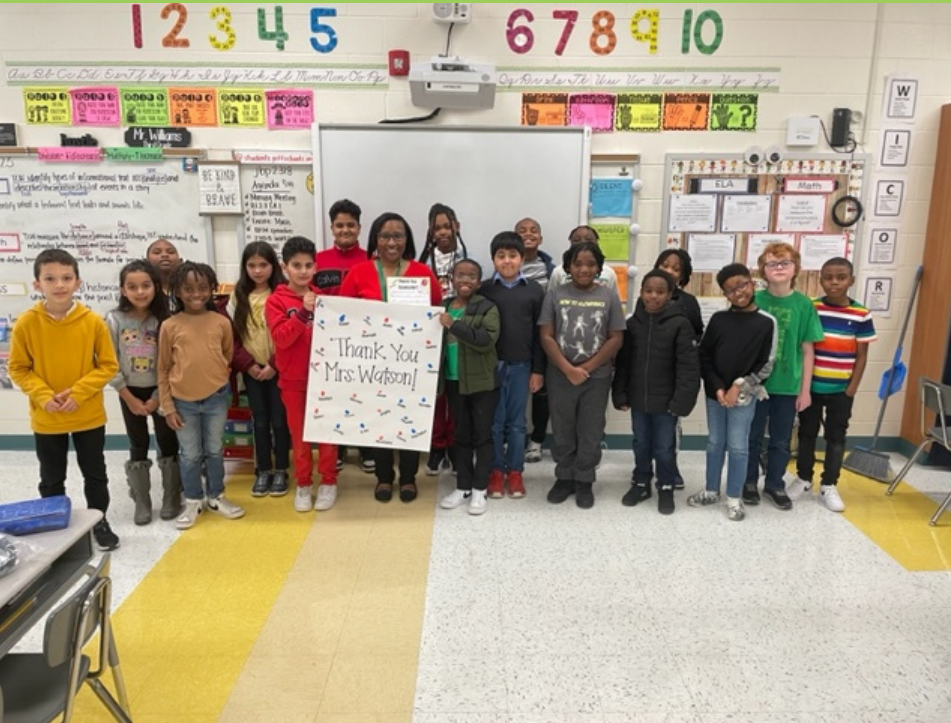

Student Leadership Group

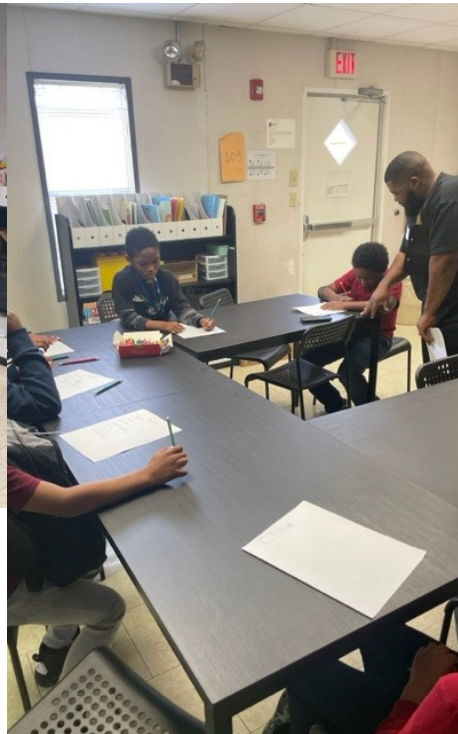
