We encourage applicants of either criterion to apply. The scholarship will be awarded on the following criteria:

The student plans to pursue a major in sports medicine.

The student has a weighted GPA of 3.0.

The student has documented hours of volunteer service.

The selection committee is composed of Bill Grimm's children and their designees. The selection committee has the responsibility of selecting the recipient and their selection is the final decision.
