

CHRIS CARTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Chris Carter was born and raised in Greenville NC and graduated from Rose High School in 1988. He first discovered he had cancer at the age of 16. After being in remission for many years, the cancer came back later as an adult. Chris ultimately lost his battle on June 12, 2004, at the age of 34. The Chris Carter Scholarship Fund was established shortly thereafter, and the First Annual Chris Carter Memorial Golf Tournament was held in September 2004 in Greenville, NC. We had 16 teams and raised enough money to fund a single \$1,000 scholarship in Chris' honor, which was awarded to a senior from JH Rose High School.

Over the next 19 years the number of scholarships given out increased dramatically, with over \$300,000 being provided by the fund. This could not have happened without the support of our major sponsors, hole sponsors, golfers, those that donated prizes and auction items, and our volunteers. This scholarship will always be a true testament to the number of lives that Chris touched during his life, and the lasting friendships that he created, and he remains forever in our hearts.

The Chris Carter Memorial Scholarship is a 1-time award in the amount of \$1,000. Your award will come from the Pitt County Board of Education and should be coordinated with your High School Guidance Counselor.
