CLASS REQUIREMENTS

All HSA students are required to take 6 HSA approved classes. Approved course lists can be found on our website and are based on your school (Traditional High Schools, IECHS, PCSECHS).

All Schools:

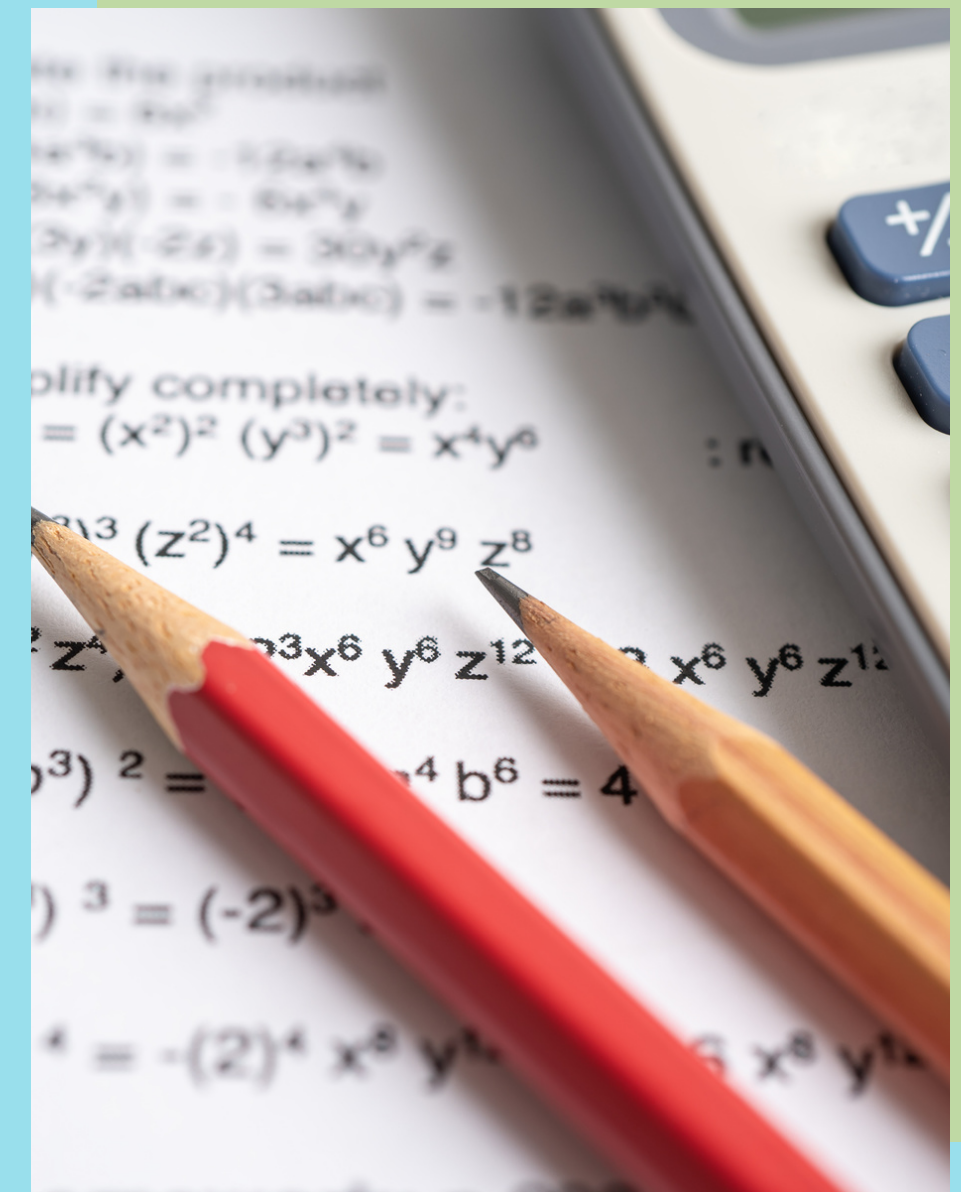
- Any Advanced Math (Math III and Higher)

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

All HSA students are required to volunteer 25 hours per school year for a total of 100 by the April 1st of their graduating year. 25 hours must be submitted to the HSA office each school year by the April 1st deadline.

Any non-profit, charity, or faith-based organization/church is approved through our HSA guidelines. If you question whether or not an agency meets our guidelines, we recommend that you communicate with the HSA office PRIOR to doing hours!

Of the 100 hours total that a student completes, at least 25 of these need to be performed in a clinical setting (i.e. doctor's office, dental office, vet office, nursing facility). Please do not worry if you cannot get these 25 medical hours during your freshman year. As long as you have medical hours by the April 1st deadline of your senior year, you will meet the requirement.

VOLUNTEER ETIQUETTE

- If you sign up, show up! If they requested volunteers, it means they need the help. Often, there are only a certain number of spots available due to spacing or needs. When you don't show up, you are leaving them with less help and sometimes more cost (if they provide food or swag to volunteers).
- Be on time! The start time listed is typically when the supervisor will give instructions for what to do. That means you need to be in place before that start time so that the supervisor does not have to waste valuable time going over the instructions for late comers.
- Be Engaged! Remember, you are there to help! This is not the time to be on your phone. Not sure what to do? Ask! Be proactive and help get the job done.
- Dress for the Job! Not sure what to wear? Ask ahead of time! Sandals and flip flops are rarely appropriate.

We get it. Life happens. If there is a good reason that you cannot make it, let the supervisor know as soon as possible so they can try to fill your spot. Wanting to sleep in, not being 'in the mood' to volunteer, and finding 'something better to do' are NOT good reasons to cancel!

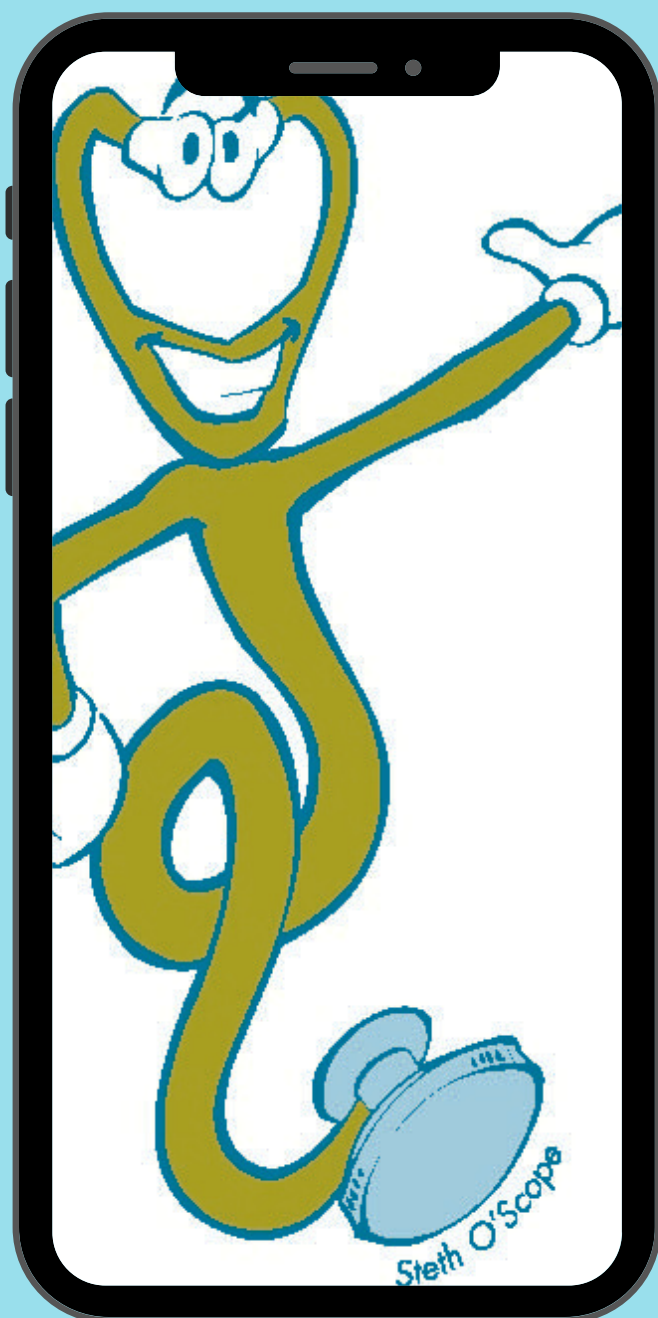
