

Pitt County Schools Strategic Plan

Goal 4: Every school in the Pitt County School system has up-to-date financial, business, and technology systems to serve its students, parents, and educators.

Objective 1: Provide every school with sufficient wireless coverage to support 1:1 computing initiatives.

Action Step1: Increase access points to provide adequate coverage to support 1:1 computing:

- Erate will be sought out for funding to support the increase in access points

Action Step 2: Continue with line item budgeting for technology purchases needed to increase student to device ratio:

- Budget line item will continue the funding of scheduled technology purchases as well as the competitive grant process

Objective 2: Pitt County Schools will use Homebase and SchoolNet as an essential resource for instructional delivery, online test administration, and communications with parents and students. Pitt County Schools will develop common assessments/benchmarks through SchoolNet to be delivered each nine/six weeks.

Action Step1: Advertise, promote, and train PowerSchool to the stakeholder base

- Market the Pitt County Schools app for parents and students
- Provide training for teachers to effectively use the Homebase/SchoolNet resource
- Ensure up-to-date student progress for parent reporting

Action Step 2: Prepare benchmarks and Common Assessments

- Using a team of teachers and curriculum personnel, create district wide benchmarks
- Benchmarks will be given three times per year in K-8, and three times a semester in Math I, Biology, and English II

Objective 3: Pitt County Schools administrators will meet all local, state and federal funding guidelines and policies.

Action Step1: Federal Programs will be monitored through the Federal Programs Department with routine audits and checks

Action Step 2: Federal guidelines for Food and Nutrition will be met. Training for administrators will be scheduled through principal meetings
