9:00 AM Friday, May 26th Awards Day Gym 1st/2nd Period

On Awards Day, Seniors and Marshals are to come dressed for Awards Day. DO NOT BRING BOOKS, BOOKBAGS, PURSES, AND HANDBAGS. THESE ITEMS ARE NOT PERMITTED INTO THE GYM.

Seniors will wear their graduation gown (NO CAP) for the Awards Day Ceremony.

Seniors will wear DRESS ATTIRE under their gowns for the Awards Day Ceremony.

By dress attire we mean:

- **dress or skirt/dress slacks and blouse**
- **WHITE** collared buttoned down dress shirts, **ties** (bow ties are acceptable), and **KHAKI PANTS**.
- **Dress Shoes.**
- **Sneakers, Jeans (denim of any kind), Golf shirts are not acceptable**

9:45 AM Senior Advisors will escort Seniors to the sidewalk for the line-up. Parents will be allowed to come into the gym for seating.

10:00 AM Seniors are in line ready to march.

The Award's Ceremony will be for **Seniors and their families this year. Parents, family and friends who cannot attend are invited to watch the live telecast through the NFHS Network online, via the app or their smart tv's. The ceremony will begin at 10:00am.**

Graduation Practice - Tuesday, June 6, 2022, 4:00pm

GRADUATION PRACTICE ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY. Seniors and Marshals will meet at Minges Coliseum **promptly at 3:45**. Enter at Gate 4. **FRIENDS AND/OR RELATIVES ARE NOT ALLOWED TO ATTEND THIS PRACTICE.** Upon entering Minges, please move directly to your assigned seat and wait for instructions. Be prepared to practice for 2 hours. Graduation tickets will be distributed the day after graduation practice between 10am and 2pm. You must attend graduation practice in order to receive your tickets as well as to participate in the Graduation Ceremony. Students will receive **8** tickets each for graduation.

1:00 pm Seniors and Marshals are in line ready to march.

2:30 pm Graduation Ceremony begins. **SENIORS WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IF THEY COME AFTER THE CEREMONY BEGINS.** No one will be allowed on the coliseum floor to take pictures. You will have an opportunity to purchase pictures taken by the school photographer.

3:30 pm Recessional. Please ask family and friends to meet you outside. The building needs to be cleared as soon as possible.

APPROPRIATE DRESS FOR GRADUATION

The proper wearing of the cap and gown adds dignity to our ceremony. Please follow these procedures:

1. The cap should be placed on the head so that the mortarboard is level. **We do not allow students to wear decorated caps during the ceremony.**
2. The tassel is to be worn over the **RIGHT** temple. The tassel should not be shifted when you receive your diploma cover. Be sure that your tassel is secure.
3. All tassels will be shifted from the **RIGHT** to the **LEFT** after all seniors have received their diploma covers and are given the signal to move the tassel during the tassel ceremony.
4. The gown must be pressed before wearing it. Place it on a coat hanger.
5. ATTIRE:
 - a. dress or skirt/dress slacks and blouse
 - b. **WHITE** collared buttoned down dress shirts, ties (bow ties are acceptable), and **KHAKI PANTS**.
 - c. Dress Shoes.
 - d. **Sneakers, Jeans (denim of any kind), Golf shirts are not acceptable**
6. Honor cords should be draped around the neck outside of the gown. Cords should hang loosely in front of the gown. They should not be intertwined or braided.

REMEMBER, YOU MAY NOT BRING ANY CELL PHONES, ELECTRONIC DEVICES, PURSES, OR BACKPACKS INTO THE COLISEUM. YOU WILL NOT BE ADMITTED INTO THE ARENA WITH THESE ITEMS AND THEY WILL NOT BE HELD FOR YOU. YOU MAY BRING ONE CAR KEY IF NECESSARY. JH ROSE HIGH SCHOOL WILL NOT BE HELD LIABLE FOR ANY OF THESE OR OTHER ITEMS IF THEY ARE LOST OR STOLEN.

“How To”

School Cash Online. It is Fast, Safe and Convenient.

1. Go to: pcs.schoolcashionline.com
2. Select the **register** option If not already registered (otherwise skip these steps)

3. A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. **Click on the link provided inside the email** to confirm your email and School Cash Online account
4. The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site, prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password to log in.
5. This step will connect your child to your account.
6. Enter the **School Board Name**.
7. Enter the **School Name**.
8. Enter your **child's student number, first name, last name, and date of birth**
9. Select **continue**
10. On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the **Agree** box and select **continue**.
11. Your child has been added to your account.
