GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students in any of the high schools in Pitt County who enter the ninth grade prior to the 2009-2010 school year must meet one of the four Course of Study diploma requirements stated in Policy 9.616 Exhibit A. Students who enter the ninth grade for the first time in 2009-2010 and thereafter must meet the diploma requirements stated in Policy 9.616 Exhibit B. Students who turn 19 years of age in the same semester as they complete the credit requirements for a North Carolina diploma are eligible for graduation.

GRADUATION PROFICIENCY

End-of-Course (EOC) Test Scores

End-of-Course test results will be used as part of the student's final grade. For Pitt County Schools, the End-of-Course Test is the final exam for high school students. Students must score at a proficient level in order to receive credit for the course. In addition, the EOC final exam grade will count 25% of the final course grade.
