Elmhurst Elementary Remote Learning Plan

Purpose:

This plan outlines expectations and procedures for students, families, and staff on days when Elmhurst Elementary transitions to **unexpected remote learning** (such as during inclement weather or other emergencies). On days in which we know far enough in advance, we will send home paper packets of worksheets.

Communication

- Families will receive notification of the remote learning day through the district's standard communication channels (phone, email, social media, dojo).
- Teachers will post assignments and directions on **ClassDojo** by **9:00 a.m.** on the remote learning day.
- Families should check ClassDojo for updates and instructions specific to their child's class.

Instructional Expectations

- No new instruction will take place during unexpected remote learning days.
- Teachers will provide practice and review activities that reinforce skills already taught in class.
- Activities may include reading, math practice, writing prompts, or other review-based learning tasks.
- As we do not send devices home, assignments and activities will not include the use of a device (or will minimally include the use of a device) for completion.

Student Participation

- Students are encouraged to complete the posted activities to stay engaged and maintain their learning progress.
- There will be **no penalty** for students who are unable to complete assignments due to technology, internet access, or family circumstances.
- Teachers will review completed work once students return to school.

Goal:

Elmhurst Elementary aims to provide consistent communication and meaningful practice opportunities for students during unexpected closures, while maintaining flexibility and understanding for families.
